We are pleased to present the findings of the 2nd Annual e-Kouros Report - the first comprehensive and continuously evolving digital record of our nation's sports ecosystem.

A year and a half ago, we took a historic step forward. We created the first complete digital repository of sports data and, on March 21, 2024, we delivered this unique resource to you—the individuals who serve sport at every level. Whether you are local government officials, stakeholders, coaches, athletes, educators, or parents, this data is designed to support your efforts.

For the first time, we gained a clear understanding of the overall scale of sport in our country—by region, federation, sport discipline, age group, gender, and for both able-bodied and disabled athletes.

Today, one year later, e-Kouros has proven to be an invaluable tool:

- For federations, in designing targeted development strategies.
- For clubs, in enhancing their visibility and reinforcing their institutional structures.
- For municipalities and regional authorities, in shaping evidence-based local and regional sports policies.
- And for the state, in making informed decisions grounded in facts rather than estimates.

We are proud to offer society as a whole—parents, youth, and citizens—access to transparent and reliable data, thereby strengthening the connection between sport, physical activity, and a healthy lifestyle.

This year, through the e-Kouros platform, we are able—clearly and with documented accuracy—to observe the distribution of the Greek sports ecosystem.

Today, we are taking a decisive step forward. We are enriching our database, introducing the first year-on-year comparative figures, and, for the first time, recording data on sports facilities.

It is important to note that, until now, we lacked a complete overview of all sports facilities. Yet these facilities remain a critical element in shaping effective policies—both for determining where new facilities are needed and for prioritizing the renovation of existing ones.

Greece has become—and I assure you, it will remain, for as long as I am entrusted with this unique and inspiring portfolio—a dynamic hub of sports infrastructure development. Projects are being implemented across the country, fairly and proportionately.

We made a commitment, and we are delivering on it. e-Kouros is no longer merely a digital archive—it is a strategic tool for policymaking, planning, and elevating sport at every level.

For the first time, we now all have access to comparable data across the full breadth of the sports landscape: sport disciplines, clubs, athletes, coaches, geographical distribution, participation by gender, and—crucially—information about the sports facilities used by clubs throughout the country.

The inclusion of data about sports facilities, reported directly by the clubs, represents a significant innovation. It provides a comprehensive digital footprint of where and how sport is practiced in Greece. This marks the first step toward digital planning for infrastructure upgrades and reallocations—based on real needs and actual usage.

Specifically, in the context of e-Kouros II/2025 the data reveals the following:

- 63 sports federations,
- 163 different sport disciplines;
- 6,374 active sports clubs;
- 18,143 registered coaches;
- And 435,337 athletes.

In addition, 109 Municipalities + 11 associated bodies implement Sport for All programmes, reaching 163,400 individuals engaged in physical activity. Finally, there are 4,998 sports facilities recorded across the country.

The comparative data from 2023 to 2024 offers highly insightful findings:

- There has been a notable increase in the total number of registered athletes: 435,337 in 2024 compared to 412,329 in 2023, representing a growth of 5.6%.
- Particularly encouraging is the rise in the proportion of female athletes—evidence that gender equality in sport is advancing steadily. In 2024, there were 128,472 female athletes, compared to 108,994 in 2023. This amounts to 29.7%, up from 26.4% the previous year.
- The number of coaches has also increased significantly, from 13,494 to 18,143. This growth reflects both a rising demand for and an emphasis on quality coaching support, validating the direction of our current policies.
- This year, football and basketball continue to lead the way, but it's worth noting that the Greek Gymnastics Federation has considerably stepped up its game, showing the most significant growth among all federations.

Equally important, the data reveals that 1 in 4 minors in Greece—equivalent to 23.2% of children and adolescents—takes part in organized sports.



However, adult participation in sport remains significantly low, dropping to just 4%—a figure that also represents the national average for athletes as a proportion of the total population. This presents a clear challenge for all of us.

We need to keep young people engaged in sports and foster a lifelong sports for all culture.

e-Kouros is more than just a database. It is the navigation system for Greek sport over the coming years. And beginning this year, with the release of its annual report, it is also becoming a permanent institution for transparency, accountability, and strategic planning.

I would like to express my sincere thanks to everyone who contributed to this important undertaking. My colleagues continue to be invaluable partners in every step of our reform journey.

With these words, I invite you to explore the latest developments and opportunities that e-Kouros offers.

Digital sport is not only here to stay—it is set to play a vital role in building the future of sport that Greece truly deserves!











MEN – WOMEN TYPICAL ATHLETES ALL OVER GREECE
















ATHLETES (MEN – WOMEN) VARIATION PER REGION




DISABILITY SPORTS CLUBS PER FEDERATION







Attica and Central Macedonia possess:
53,5% of the total Greek population
54,8% of the total typical athletes of the country and
69% of the total athletes with disabilities



Therefore, instead of being at a rate of **45%** in the rest Greek territory, the athletes with disabilities possess **31%**, meaning lack of ease for them to engage sports, except Attica and Central Macedonia regions.




In Thessaly region there was a particular increase from 3 to 5 sports clubs, meaning a 67% increase.






OLYMPIC MEDALS PER SPORT POSTWAR SINCE 1956 (MELBOURNE)






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






IRREGULAR FINDINGS FROM TESTINGS CONDUCTED IN 2024
